ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Texas Department of State Health Services is awarding funding to enhance epidemiology and laboratory capacity to rapidly identify and investigate possible outbreaks of the Zika virus, and to prepare for and respond to the emerging Zika virus threat. The funding will support temporary personnel, fringe, supplies, training, travel and indirect costs associated with Zika preparedness and response. The Austin Public Health Department was recently notified of an additional \$47,716 of funding and an extension of the current contract award term to July 31, 2019.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Austin Public Health Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
