

#### **Help Save Our Creeks** and Barton Springs Pool

Tighly destructive zebra mussels Thave invaded many popular Central exas waters, and Austin's local creeks nd Barton Springs are now at risk. In Barton Springs Pool, zebra mussels would boost algae growth, cut people's feet, crease maintenance costs and pose a threat to the endangered salamanders. Unfortunately, this invasive species preads easily from one body of water another. Zehra mussel larvae are nvisible to the naked eye, and millions of them can live undetected on wet

items for days. These larvae can form new colonies when introduced into another body of water.

- · Clean and dry all toys, coolers. rafts, buckets and other items.
- · Clean and dry your dogs between swims.
