15 (c) the entrance or exit of a check cashing business; or

17 ~~(5) on either side of the street on a block where a school attended by~~  
18 ~~minors or a child care facility has an entrance or exit;~~  
19 ~~(6)](4) at a sidewalk café authorized under Chapter 14-4 (*Sidewalk Cafés*)  
20 or the patio area of a bar or restaurant. [~~;~~ ~~or~~  
21 ~~(7) in the downtown business area described in Section 9-4-14 (*Sitting or*~~  
22 ~~*Lying Down on Public Sidewalks in the Downtown Business Area*~~

25 **PART 4.** Subsection (D) of City Code Section 9-4-13 (*Solicitation Prohibited*) is  
26 amended to read as follows:

28 A culpable mental state is not required, and need not be proved, for an offense  
29 under this Section 9-4-13[~~Subsection (C)(2), (3), or (4)~~].
