

Staff response to BAC [Recommendation 20180515-04B](#)

The Right-of-Way Management Division will be working with the Active Transportation and Traffic Engineering divisions to create a Mobility Guideline for bicycle considerations. We will work on this over the summer and hope to present a draft guideline to the Bicycle Advisory Commission in the fall. Other mobility guidelines will be updated in conjunction with the new guideline relating to bicycles.

Building on the work of the Austin Street Design Guide, the Austin Transportation Department has begun working with the Public Works Department and other City staff on an update to the Transportation Criteria Manual (TCM). The update, which will include a rewrite of many sections of the document, will include updated street designs as well as bicycle and end-of-trip facility standards. The TCM update will also include updated temporary traffic control standards around work zones, including bicycle and pedestrian accommodations. The Bicycle Advisory Council's recommendations will be considered in the drafting of the new content for the TCM. A draft TCM is projected for public review and comment in the fall of 2018.
