AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 200 EAST 18 $^{\text {th }}$ STREET FROM GENERAL COMMERCIAL SERVICES (CS) DISTRICT AND COMMERCIAL LIQUOR SALES (CS-1) DISTRICT TO CENTRAL BUSINESS (CBD) DISTRICT.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from general commercial services (CS) district and commercial liquor sales (CS-1) district to central business (CBD) district on the property described in Zoning Case No. C14-2018-0029, on file at the Planning and Zoning Department, as follows:

A tract of land containing 2.0422 acres ( 88,957 square feet), being all of Outlot 51, Division "E" of the Government Outlots adjoining the Original City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, according to the plat on file at the General Land Office of the State of Texas, conveyed to the Employees Retirement System of Texas in Volume 4963, Page 1453;. Volume 2936, Page 354; Volume 4531, Page 1041; Volume 4537, Page 2266; and Volume 5336, Page 2373, all of the Deed Records of Travis County, Texas; said 2.0422 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit "A" incorporated into this ordinance (the "Property"),
locally known as 200 East $18^{\text {th }}$ Street in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, generally identified in the map attached as Exhibit "B".

PART 2. This ordinance takes effect on July 9, 2018.
