Authorize award and execution of a construction contract with **Matous Construction**, for Hornsby Bend Biosolids Management Plant Thickener Complex Rehabilitation in the amount of \$14,840,000 plus a \$1,484,000 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$16,324,000. (ETJ)

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Capital Budget of Austin Water.

Purchasing Language:	Lowest responsive bid of two bids received through a competitive Invitation for Bid solicitation.

MBE/WBE:	This contract will be awarded in compliance with City Code Chapter 2-9A (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) by meeting the goals with 19.70% MBE and 1.16% WBE participation.

The Hornsby Bend Biosolids Management Plant receives all solids generated by Austin's two regional wastewater treatment plants, Walnut Creek and South Austin Regional. These solids are treated by thickening (Thickener Complex), anaerobic digestion, then are dewatered and composted. The Thickener Complex serves as a critical treatment process between the headworks (screening) and the anaerobic digesters.

The current thickening system utilizes Gravity Belt Thickeners. These Gravity Belt Thickeners are beyond their useful life (installed in 1990) and the associated electrical infrastructure is severely corroded and compromised. This construction project replaces the Gravity Belt Thickeners with more advanced centrifuges, a high speed process that uses the force from rapid rotation of a cylindrical bowl to separate wastewater solids from liquid, to ensure long-term thickening reliability and to contain corrosive gasses and odors from the thickening process.

Major benefits resulting from this project will include a significant reduction in the amount of wash water needed, significant odor/hydrogen sulfide gas containment, a safer work environment, and a significant increase to process reliability and infrastructure stability due to the replacement of corroded and aging thickening equipment and its associated electrical infrastructure.

Prompt action is requested on this item to ensure the project moves into the construction phase. Failure to construct this project in a timely manner may result in unplanned thickening equipment and/or electrical failures at the Hornsby Biosolids Management Plant impacting the facility's ability to process bio-solids.

Due to the potential for unforeseen conditions in rehabilitating aging infrastructure, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. A contingency is an additional amount of money added to the construction budget to cover any unforeseen construction costs associated with the project.

The contract allows 1,825 calendar days for completion of this project. Although all Work is to be substantially completed within 730 Calendar Days after Notice to Proceed, final completion will be given an additional 1095 Calendar Days for centrifuge manufacturer routine maintenance/support services.

This project is located within zip code 78725 (District ETJ). The project will be managed by Public Works Department.

M/WBE Summary

Public notice was given for this solicitation (CLMC712, Hornsby Bend Biosolids Management Plant Thickener Complex Rehabilitation), through the City's Vendor Connection web portal. Two bids were received and opened on June 7, 2018. Of the two bids received none of the firms submitting were certified MBE/WBE. Matous Construction submitted the lowest responsive bid of two bids received including an allowance of \$75,000:


