Watershed Protection Amendments – Discuss and consider amendments to Title 25 and 30 of the City Code, including Section 25-8-25 (Redevelopment Exception in Urban and Suburban Watersheds), Section 25-8-26 (Redevelopment Exception in the Barton Springs Zone), Section 25-8-27 (Redevelopment Exception in the Water Supply Rural and Water Supply Suburban Watersheds), Section 25-8-211 (Water Quality Control Requirement), and Section 30-5-211 (Water Quality Control Requirement).
