# **Additional Backup Information:**

A request has been received for subsurface encroachment of the Comal Street right-of-way for a proposed private underground electrical and communication duct bank. The subsurface encroachment is approximately 382 square feet, and will contain a proposed private underground electrical and communication duct bank.

The total appraised value for the encroachment is \$6,689. A check in the amount of the appraised value has been submitted to the Office of Real Estate Services for processing upon approval of this encroachment request. In addition, the applicant has reimbursed the City for the cost of the appraisal

and the cost of the notice requirements sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to registered neighborhood associations whose boundaries include the area of proposed encroachment. No objections were received.
