



23 interests in the community served including, but not limited to, business, industry labor,  
24 religious, law enforcement or education stakeholders; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the new term for all fifteen members of the Community Development  
26 Commission will begin March 1, 2019; and

27 **WHEREAS**, a specific Council Committee or Council Committees responsible for  
28 nominating the seven members to the Community Development Commission that will  
29 represent the public and private sectors must be designated; **NOW, THEREFORE:**

30 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

31 The Housing and Planning Committee is designated as the Council Committee  
32 responsible for nominating three public sector members and one private sector member to  
33 the Community Development Commission.

34 The Health and Human Services Committee is designated as the Council Committee  
35 responsible for nominating two public sector members and one private sector member to  
36 the Community Development Commission.

37 The City Manager is directed to implement this new process of having the Housing  
38 and Planning Committee and Health and Human Services Committee nominate the public  
39 and private sector members of the Community Development Commission for terms  
40 beginning after February 28, 2019.

44 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

45 In the interim before new terms begin on March 1, 2019, the Housing and Planning  
46 Committee shall nominate four public sector members.

47 In the interim before new terms begin on March 1, the current three public and  
48 private sector members of the Community Development Commission are recognized as  
49 one public sector member currently representing Mayor Steve Adler and two private sector  
50 members.
