Additional Backup Information:

This ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 20170913-004 and establishes all positions in the classified service of the Austin Police Department. The number of positions in the civil service classification of Police Sergeant of this ordinance is increasing by two (2) and Police Corporal/Police Detective is increasing by seven (7) from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance. Two (2) of the Police Corporal/Detective positions will become effective upon adoption of this ordinance and five (5) will become effective April 1, 2019. The number of positions in the civil service classification of Police Officer of this ordinance is an increase of twelve (12) from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance. The civil service classification of the Austin Police Department

and the number of positions in each classification are established as follows:

Assistant Chief - 6 Commander - 18 Police Lieutenant - 69 Police Sergeant - 187 Police Corporal/Police Detective - 390 Police Officer - 1,259
