Katie Deoloz read aloud the names of eight people whose deaths due to traffic crashes on Austin streets have been reported since the PAC last met: Troy Dean Fisher, Scott Gerald Whiting, Brandon Thomas Buentello, Jacoby Ray Bailey, Luis Cristobal Landeros, David O'Beirne, Tennie Ross, and Ernesto Garcia Gonzales.

5. ITEMS FROM STAFF

A. Dockless Mobility Program Update and Discussion – Briefing and Possible Action

Jacob Culberson, Mobility Services Division Manager, Austin Transportation Department (ATD), Jason Redfern, Parking Enterprise Manager, ATD, Laura Dierenfield, Active Transportation and Street Design Division Manager, ATD, briefed the PAC on Dockless Mobility Program and the upcoming process for establishing a Final Rule governing dockless mobility services in the City of Austin. Ricardo Soliz, Acting Programs Divisions Assistant Director, Parks and Recreation Department (PARC) and Amanda Ross, Natural Resources Division Manager, PARC were also present.
