Subject: Development Services Department FY 18-19 Budget

RATIONALE:

WHEREAS, Development Services Department (DSD) is transitioning from a general revenue source of funding to an Enterprise fund source in FY 2019. This transition will result in significant fee increases; and

WHEREAS, Development Services Department is requesting 50 new full-time positions.

THEREFORE, the Environmental Commission recommends support of the request for the proposed DSD Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget proposal with the following:

Environmental Commission Conditions:

- the proposed fees are phased in over time using the fund balance to fund the difference;
- DSD conduct a thorough review and update of the Criteria Manuals to identify conflicting information between departments and to simplify the process as much as possible;
- assess the fees based on the approved plans or as reviews are completed and comments cleared rather than all upfront; and
- continue to evaluate and work with the Environmental Commission subcommittees regarding erosion control inspections throughout the City.
