ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT: This written examination shall be held in accordance with the Agreement between the City of Austin and the Austin-Travis County EMS Employees Association and with Civil Service law and rules, and shall be open to each Clinical Specialist-Communications (formerly Medic II – Communications) who has continuously held this classification for at least two (2) years immediately before the date of the written examination, and who has four (4) years of service in the Department.

In addition, it is the responsibility of candidates seeking education points to ensure that the Human Resource Section of the Department has the necessary supporting documentation for education points. The documentation must be received by the HR Section no later than 5:00 PM, December 4, 2018. No education points will be counted unless proper documentation is timely received.

ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION FOR WRITTEN EXAMINATION: As required by Civil service Commission Rule 7.06, all eligible candidates who intend to take the examination <u>MUST</u> register.
