**RESOLUTION NO.**

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Civil Service Commission has been established to ensure general compliance with applicable provisions of Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code, the local Civil Service Rules established by the Commission, and any current agreements between the City of Austin and associations representing firefighters, police officers, and emergency medical services personnel.

**WHEREAS**, the Commission may take action on matters related to promotion, appeals of promotional exams, suspension and termination as well as other matters regarding firefighters, police officers and emergency medical services personnel in accordance with the above-mentioned statutes, rules and agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 143.006 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that the City Manager will appoint three Commissioners for staggered terms, and that the appointment must be confirmed by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, if a vacancy occurs, the City Manager shall appoint a person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Andrew Harris resigned from the Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Civil Service Commission on July 2, 2018. His unexpired term ends on December 6, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has appointed Mr. Ronald Morgan to fill the vacancy on the Commission created by Commissioner Harris' resignation. Mr.

Morgan was appointed to serve the unexpired term ending December 6, 2019. Mr. Morgan meets the statutory prerequisites for appointment to this position; and

**WHEREAS**, a vacancy will exist for the Firefighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission at the expiration of Commissioner Eyna Canales-Zarate's current term on October 31, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager reappointed Eyna Canales-Zarate to another three-year term, expiring October 31, 2021. Ms. Canales-Zarate meets the statutory prerequisites for appointment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Council confirms the City Manager's appointment of Ronald Morgan to the Fire Fighters', Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Civil Service Commission for the unexpired term ending on December 6, 2019.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The City Council confirms the City Manager's reappointment of Eyna Canales-Zarate to the Fire Fighter's, Police Officers' and Emergency Medical Services Personnel's Civil Service Commission for another term that begins on November 1, 2018 and expires on October 31, 2021.
