Street name change case process overview

1. Application received
2. ATD & CTM Addressing process application and ensure proposed name meets requirements
3. Case information sent to property owners abutting Manchaca Road
4. Abutting property owners complete opinion survey
5. Case information and concur review forms sent to seven agencies for review
6. Public hearing
7. Council decision
8. *If approved:* Property owners sent notice of Council action and Notice of Address Change
9. *If approved:* ATD sends notice to various internal and external agencies
10. *If approved:* ATD Signs & Markings Division fabricates and installs new signs
