The Council recognizes that the City has no authority under the State Constitution or the Texas Public Funds Investment Act to invest directly in any company in such a manner that the City would become a stockholder in the company.

18 The Council directs the City Manager to take the steps identified above in a manner that 19 is consistent with the requirements of the Texas Public Funds Investment Act (Texas 20 Government Code Section 2256.005) to ensure understanding of the suitability of an investment 21 for the City, and to primarily emphasize, in order of priority, preservation and safety of principal,
