Management Services

Approve an ordinance transferring funds within the City for homelessness services as follows: amending the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 General Fund, Austin Public Health Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20180911-001) to transfer out \$694,733 and: transfer in \$193,602 to the Emergency Medical Services Operating Budget and add 1.0 full-time equivalent (FTE); transfer in \$313,643 to the Municipal Court Operating Budget and add 1.0 FTE; and transfer in \$187,488 to the Austin Police Operating Budget.

Additional Backup Information:

City Council increased funding for homelessness efforts in the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Operating Budget by \$3.5 million, in addition to the approximately \$26.0 million of homelessness-related funding already included in the Operating Budget for contracts and other staff-efforts. Of the \$3.5 million, Council

allocated an additional \$1.0 million dollars to the Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget. This ordinance will authorize a transfer of \$694,733 of the \$1.0 million from the Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget to other City Departments as follows:

- Emergency Medical Services: \$193,602 (\$100,503 in one-time costs and \$93,099 in ongoing costs) for a Sworn Clinical Specialist position, a vehicle, and vehicle fleet and maintenance.
 Funding for one-time items will revert to the Austin Public Health budget in Fiscal Year 2019-2020.
- Municipal Court: \$313,643 within Downtown Austin Community Court for a Clinical Case
 Manager position, direct services funding, and Rapid Rehousing funding.
- · Austin Police Department: \$187,488 for ARCH security.

The Austin Public Health Operating Budget will maintain the remaining \$305,267 for homelessness efforts.
