RESOLUTION

PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

MARCH 26, 1991

WHEREAS the Parks and Recreation Department budget has been cut in each of the past six years; and

WHEREAS public usage of parks is at an all time high; and

WHEREAS, as a result, basic parks facilities are suffering serious degradation and basic programs have been cut to the bone; and

WHEREAS additional budget cuts will reduce facility maintenance and program operation below acceptable limits;

THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Parks and Recreation Department be excused from having to make any additional budget cuts other than in the following areas:

Closing Palm Pool
Backcharges to other Departments wherever possible
Increase CIP Charges
Vacancy Savings from AIPP Position
Miscellaneous Reductions

WE FURTHER RESOLVE that no fee increases be required in any case.

This Resolution was passed unanimously at the Parks and Recreation Board Meeting held on March 26, 1991.
