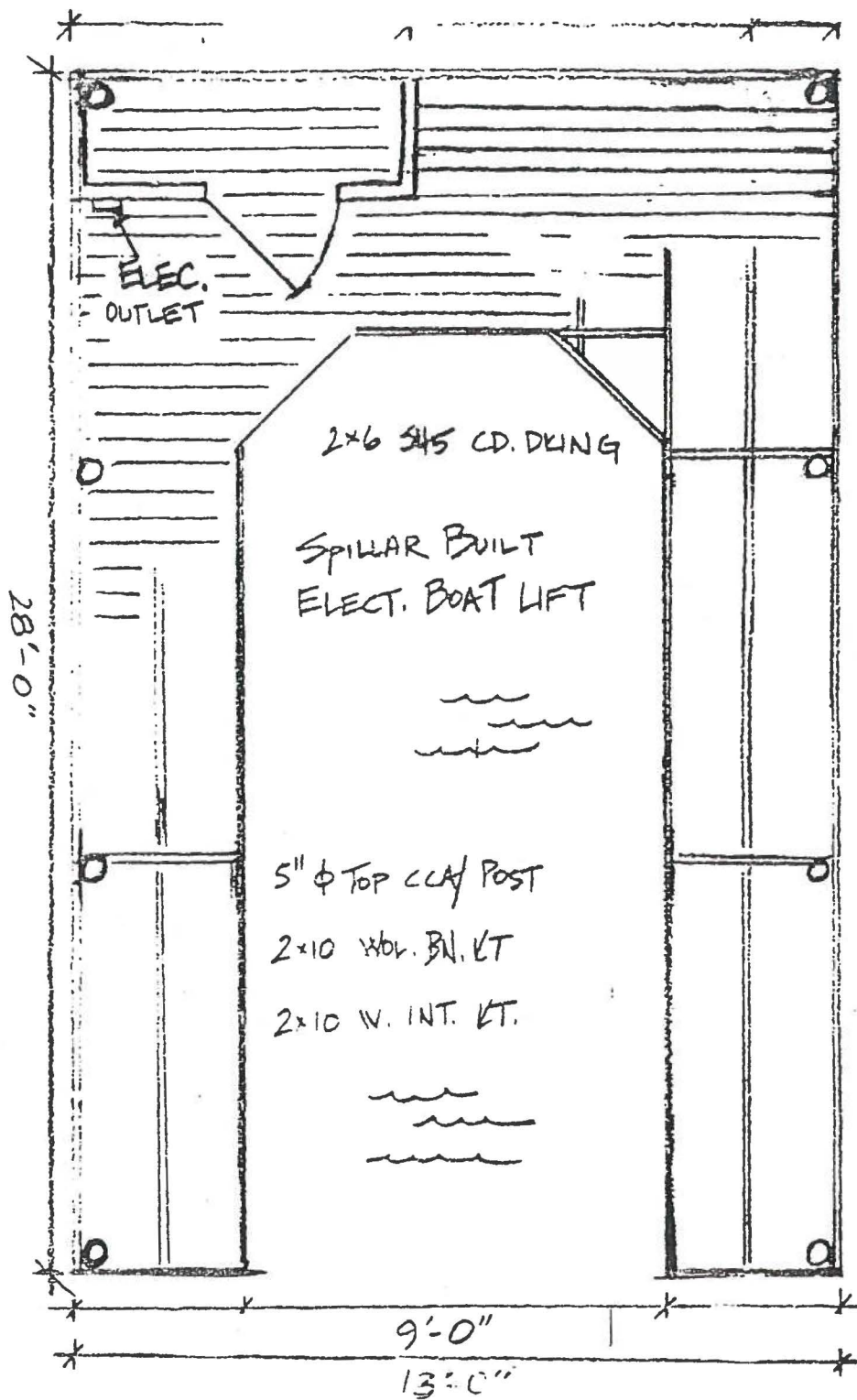
A request has been received Steve Stone to construct a boat dock at 1802 Lakeshore Drive on Lake Austin.

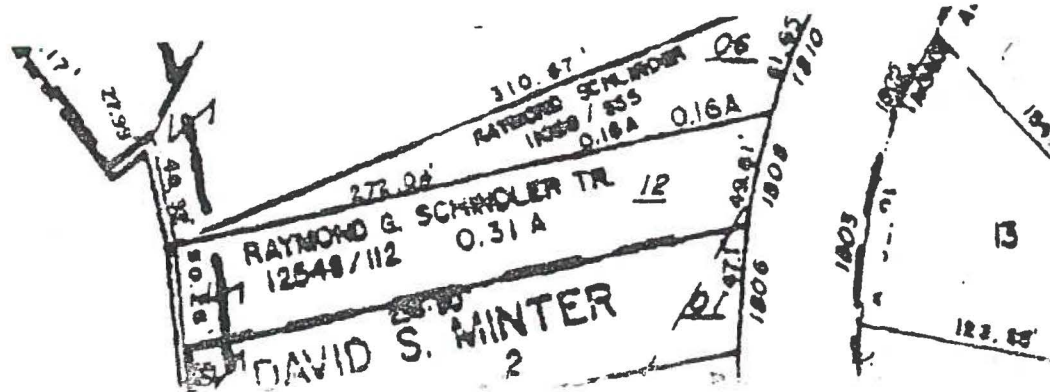

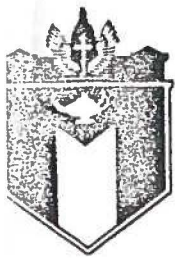

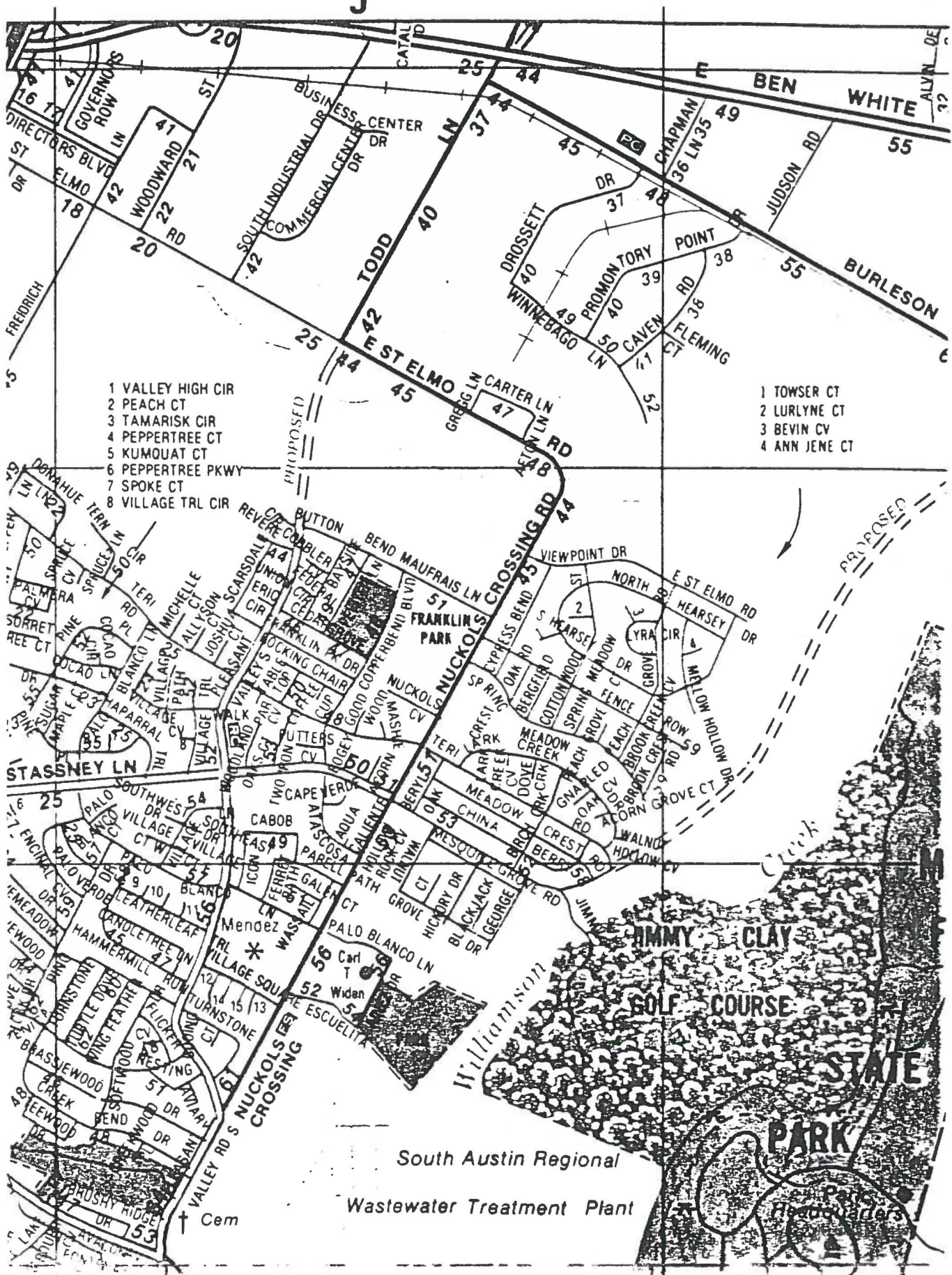

**Resolution Concerning  
Town Lake Park Master Plan**

**WHEREAS** Town Lake Park and the various facilities located in the Park are within the authority of the Parks and Recreation Board (the Board) to give advice and make recommendations to City Council and the City Manager on matters concerning the acquisition, development, management, maintenance and use of all City of Austin Parks, including Town Lake Park and its facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Recreation Board (the Board) has reviewed the Town Lake Park Master Plan (the Plan) which has been presented to the Board as a general master plan with specific details to be developed at later dates; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan was prepared by EDAW, Inc. in association with Jose Martinez and Associates, Winterowd Associates and TBG Partners based upon and in consideration of the ideas and recommendations of Parks and Recreation Department staff, members of the public and representatives of various stakeholder groups, all of whom participated in numerous design workshops and meetings held concerning the Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board supports Town Lake Park becoming a great urban park and believes this Plan achieves this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has an interest in maintaining the integrity and purpose of Town Lake Park and believes this Plan achieves this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board wishes to ensure that sufficient funds are made available to achieve both the development and maintenance of Town Lake Park under the Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, all concessions that are considered for operation within City of Austin parks, including Town Lake Park, must be reviewed for recommendation by the Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) Concession Committee and by the Board before the concession can locate or operate within the parks, including within Town Lake Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board is aware that certain PARD offices currently serving the public from Dawson Center and Riverside Center within the boundaries of Town Lake Park are proposed to be eliminated under the Plan. These offices currently contain Seniors Program, Park Police, Sports Management, Aquatics, Natural Resources and Programs staff which will be relocated; and

**WHEREAS** the Board recognizes that the details of the Plan concerning the proposed closure of Riverside Drive will be decided by City Council based upon additional information and public input available to Council; however, the Parks Board believes the Town Lake Park will benefit from the closure of Riverside Drive.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Parks and Recreation Board approves the Town Lake Park Master Plan in concept and recommends that the Austin City Council approve the Town Lake Park Master Plan.
