Subject: 3919 Westlake Drive (SP-2018-0320DS) variance request to allow the construction of a boat dock within a 150-foot critical environmental feature (canyon rimrock/seep complex) 25-8-281 (C)(2)(b)

RATIONALE:

WHEREAS, the property is in the Lake Austin watershed which is a Water Supply Rural watershed, is in the Drinking Water Protection Zone, Limited Purpose Jurisdiction and the critical environmental feature is a canyon rimrock/seep complex; and

WHEREAS, LDC 25-8-281 (C)(2)(b) prohibits construction within the 150-foot buffer of a critical environmental feature and 25-8-42(1) prohibits granting an administrative variance for development within 500 feet of the Lake Austin shoreline; and

WHEREAS, the project involves replacing an existing dock that is in poor condition and all work will be done from a barge and no trees are to be removed or impacted. In addition, the existing canyon rimrock and seep complex will not be impacted by this boat dock replacement; and

WHEREAS, according to staff, the variance request meets the finding of facts and is supported.

THEREFORE, the Environmental Commission recommends support of the request for a variance to allow the construction of a boat dock within the 150-foot critical environmental feature buffer (canyon rimrock/seep complex).
