

32 (A) Except as provided in Subsections (B) through (D), an outdoor music venue must
33 operate sound equipment consistent with its approved sound impact plan.

34 (B) An outdoor music venue may operate sound equipment between 10:00 a.m.
35 beginning on December 31, 2018, and 1:00 a.m. on January 1, 2019, if the outdoor music
36 venue is located beyond:

37 (1) 600 feet of property zoned and used as residential and is authorized by its sound
38 impact plan to operate sound equipment until 12:00 midnight on Fridays or
39 Saturdays; or

40 (2) 100 feet of property zoned and used as residential and is authorized by Section 9-2-
41 14(C)(1)(c) to operate sound equipment until 12:00 midnight on Fridays or
42 Saturdays, and the permit holder reaches an agreement with:

43 (a) owners and representatives of nearby property; and

44 (b) representatives of affected neighborhood organizations.

45 (C) On December 31, 2018, an outdoor music venue that is located beyond 100 feet of
46 property zoned and used as residential and is not authorized to operate sound equipment
47 until 12:00 midnight on Fridays or Saturdays may operate sound equipment consistent
48 with the hours established in the sound impact plan for a Friday or Saturday if the permit
49 holder reaches an agreement with:

50 (1) owners and representatives of nearby property; and

51 (2) representatives of affected neighborhood organizations.

52 (D) On December 31, 2018, an outdoor music venue that is not described in Subsection
53 (B) or (C) may operate sound equipment consistent with the hours established in the
54 sound impact plan for a Friday or Saturday.

55 **PART 4.** The City Council directs the City Manager to prepare and present an
56 ordinance that amends Chapter 9-2 (*Noise and Amplified Sound*) to establish hours to
57 operate sound equipment on New Year's Eve at a permitted outdoor music venue.
