Authorize an amendment to an existing contract with Primate Technologies, Inc., for enhancements of control room visualization software and continued maintenance and support, to increase the amount by \$618,750 and extend the term for up to five years, for a total revised total contract amount not to exceed \$1,372,160. (Note: This contract is exempt from the City Code Chapter 2-9C Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established).

Additional Backup Information:

The proposed amendment is to replace the existing application programming interfaces (APIs) for Primate software, which facilitates visual communication for control rooms. The new APIs are necessary for the system to integrate and accept information supplied by the upgraded Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and Energy Management systems, which are incompatible with the existing APIs. Primate software is used for the video display wall at Austin Energy's System Control Center (SCC) to analyze electrical distribution outage data. This amendment also includes software updates and ongoing software maintenance, support, and minor enhancements.

The current contract is for software licenses, implementation, support services, and production environment hardware for SCC as a result of a competitive solicitation. The proposed software updates will deliver technologically advanced situational awareness and visualization that are needed by Austin Energy's transmission and distribution operators for managing optimal electrical system load distribution, connectivity and related real time outage analysis. The software provides a computer-generated, consolidated and integrated video wall and desktop visualization based on real time SCADA telemetry. This software provides the necessary adherence and compliance to the North American Electric Reliability Corporation standards, security policies, and business continuity and disaster recovery plans. The current contract will expire December 31, 2018.
