

ORDINANCE NO. 20181115-021

AN ORDINANCE NAMING AN UNNAMED PARK ROAD LOCATED SOUTH OF SLAUGHTER LANE AND VINEMONT DRIVE IN CIRCLE C RANCH ON SLAUGHTER CREEK PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Findings.

- (A) On, January 28, 1964 Officer Donald E. Carpenter, of the Austin Police Department, and his partner, Officer Bobby Sides, responded to a burglary call when the suspect opened fired and struck both officers. On January 30, 1964, Officer Donald Eugene Carpenter succumbed to his wounds; he was 28 years old at the time of death.
- (B) Don Carpenter loved his profession and the community he served, and his dedication still lives on through those who remember him and those who honor his memory.
- (C) The City Council desires to recognize Donald E. Carpenter's contributions appropriately and for future remembrance.


PART 2. Council authorizes naming the unnamed park road located south of Slaughter Lane and Vinemont Drive in Circle C Ranch Metropolitan Park on Slaughter Creek, Donald E. Carpenter Way, as authorized in City Code Section 14-5-4(7) (*Allowed Reasons for Street Name Change*).


