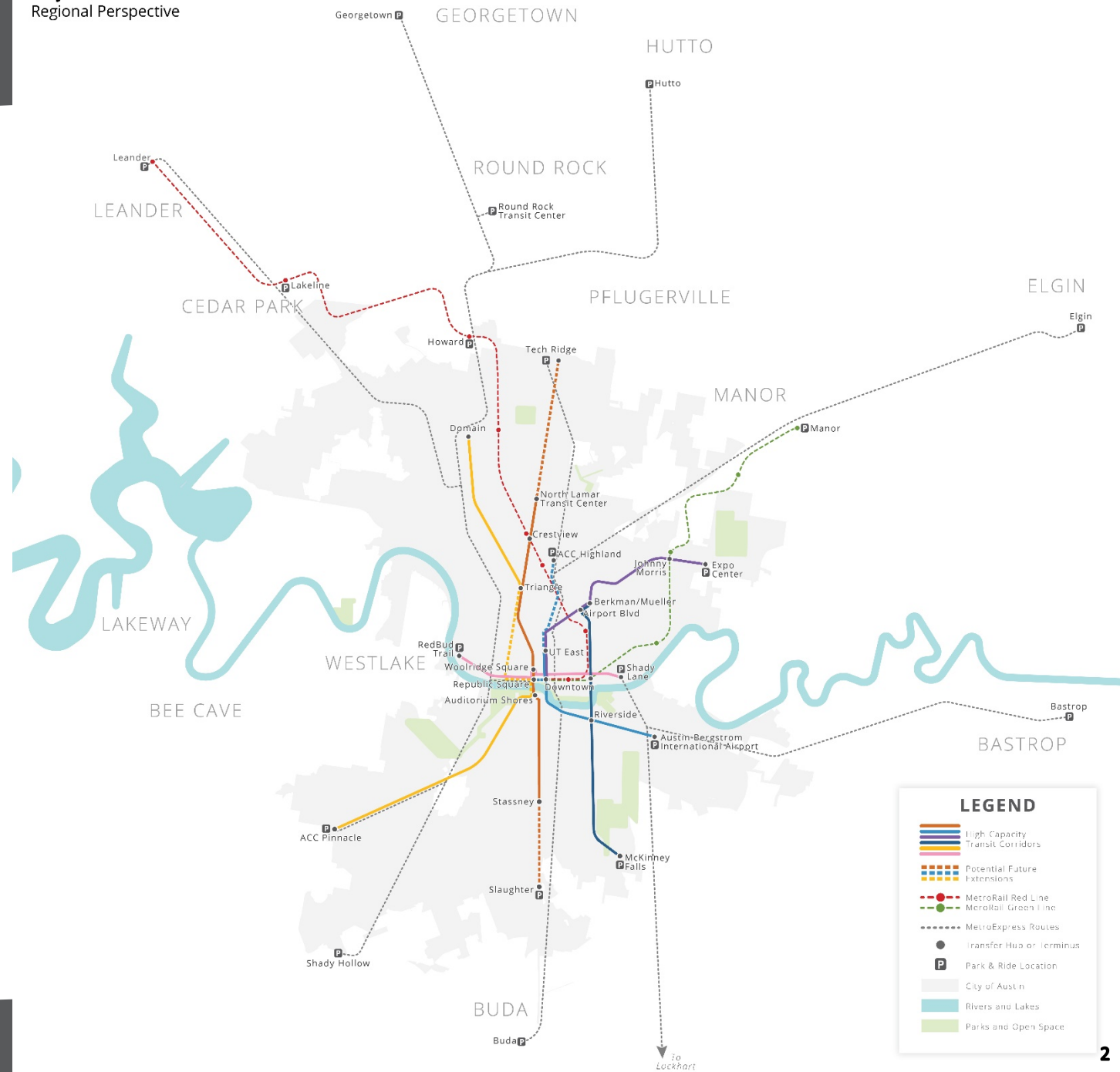

Express or Limited Stop service from West/NW

### **Southwest**

Park & Ride near S. Bay Lane and S. MoPac

### **Manchaca**

Yellow Line Extension on Manchaca

### **Pleasant Valley**

Connection between Pleasant Valley and Burleson Rd.

### **Central Austin V1**

Blue Line connection to Orange Line

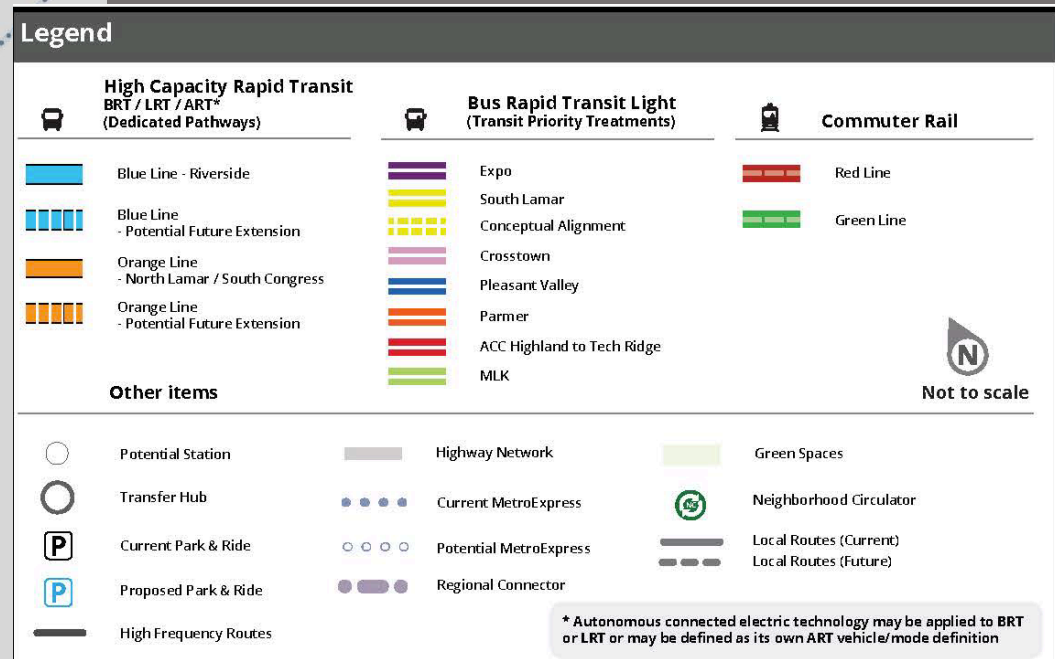
### **Central Austin V2**

Connections for Blue, Red, Orange & Green Lines plus Gold Line





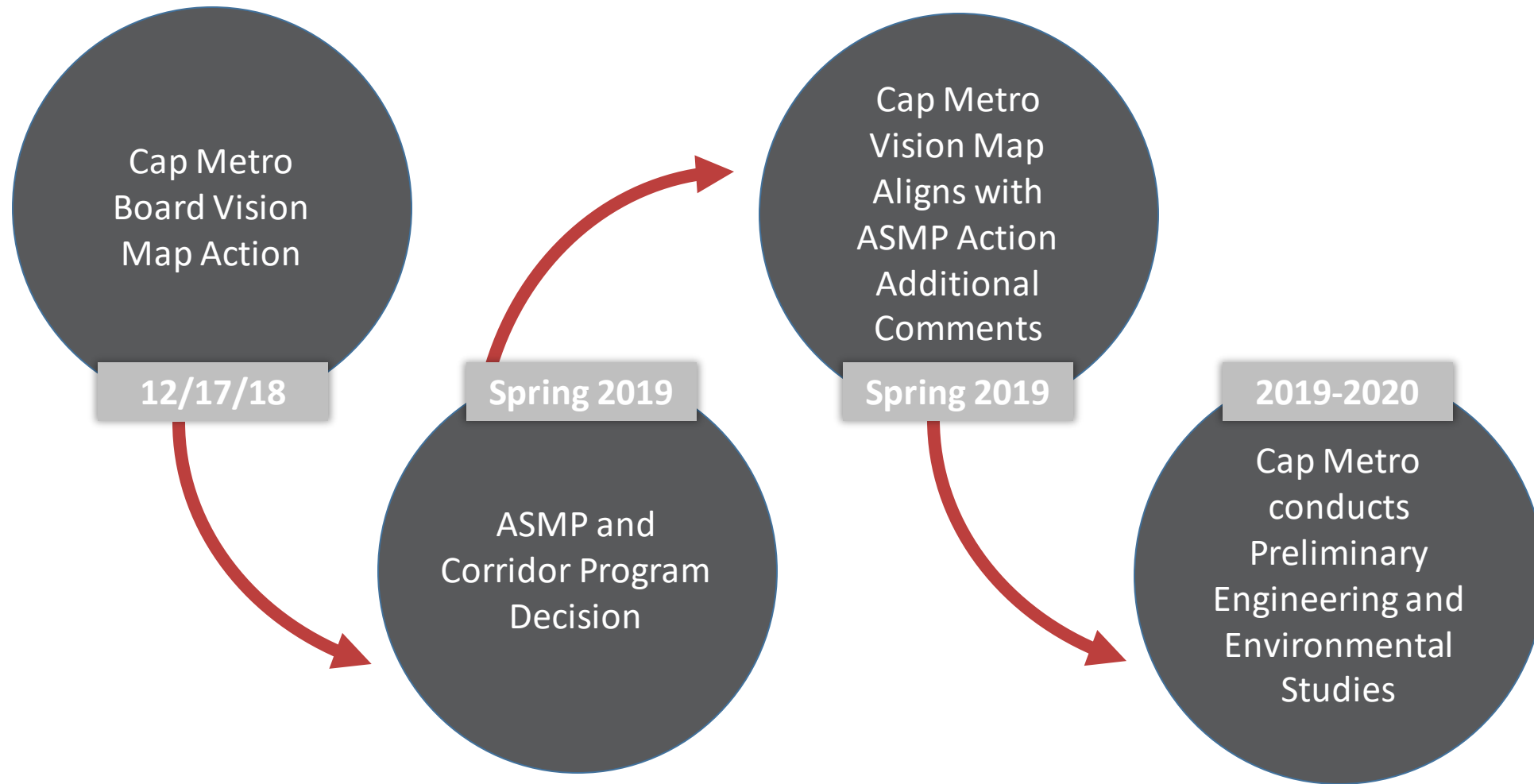
# Summary of Proposed Vision Map Adjustments *Not including Central Austin*
