2004 Fiesta de Independencia

This item on the September 2, 2004 Council Agenda would fall under the following requirements of the City Code:

- \* Section 14-8-11(B) -- Application Required (Application and Sound Permit Fees)
- \* Section 14-8-12(A) -- Security Deposit
- \* Section 14-8-21(B) -- Issuance of Permit (Applicable Fees).
- \* Ordinance 030908-4 -- Fee Requirements

Under these provisions, the following fees would be applicable to the September 15, 2004, Fiesta de la Indepencia:

\$ 50 Application Fee \$ Sound Amplification Fee 30 \$ 50 Electric Use Fee \$ 300 Rental Fee 500 Permit Fee Total fees waived 930

Other non-fee waiver costs include City resource support as follows:

| \$ 700   | EMS charges (8 hours plus setup)     |
|----------|--------------------------------------|
| \$ 858   | PARD Police                          |
| S 750    | Portable toilets and dumpster (PARD) |
| \$ 1,700 | Barricades-TPSD                      |
| S 4,008  | Total other costs waived             |

In summary, total fee waivers are \$930, other City resource support is \$4,008, for a total cost impact of \$4,938. This is one of the city co-sponsored special events per Resolution No. 021003-40.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduce potential revenues that could be realized.
