

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2018

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a regular meeting on Tuesday, November 20, 2018 in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 301 West Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 2:06 p.m. Mayor Pro Tem Tovo and Council Members Casar and Troxclair were absent.

- 1. Approve a resolution canvassing the results of the November 6, 2018 general and special elections.
 - Resolution No. 20181120-001 was approved on Council Member Alter's motion, Council Member Garza's second on an 8-0 vote. Mayor Pro Tem Tovo and Council Members Casar and Troxclair were absent.
- 2. Approve an ordinance ordering a runoff election to be held in the City of Austin on December 11, 2018 for the purpose of electing City Council Members (single member districts) for District 1, District 3, and District 8; making provision for the conduct of the election; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. 20181120-002 was approved on Council Member Houston's motion, Council Member Pool's second on an 8-0 vote. Mayor Pro Tem Tovo and Council Members Casar and Troxclair were absent.

Mayor Adler adjourned the meeting at 2:14 p.m. without objection.

The minutes were approved on this the 13th day of December 2018 on Council Member Garza's motion, Council Member Alter's second on an 8-0 vote. Mayor Adler and Council Member Flannigan were off the dais. Council Member Renteria was absent.
