

LGBTQ Quality of Life Advisory Commission MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING Monday, November 19, 2018

- **d.** Commissioner Azhar discussed opportunities for LGBTQ outreach and engagement related to the 2020 Census. Commissioners Azhar, Baeza, and Skidmore will form a working group on the topic.
