

- Repeated annually to maintain flexibility, with transparency, accountability and responsiveness to the community.







About the 2019 Mobility Annual Plan In November 2016, the City of Austin voti approved a \$720 million mobility bond package that includes \$101 million in unding for Regional Mobility projects, \$480 million for Corridor Improvement projects and \$137 million in Local Mobility projects

The Mobility Annual Plan (MAP) is an annual coordination process being used to coordinate across the entire 2016 Bond Program. The 2019 MAP provides an annual look ahead" at planned work across the entire city, made possible through 2016 Mobility Bond resources. This process is designed to provide a transparent and flexible means of delivering a very dynamic interdependent and complex set of bond funded projects.


About This Map




