#### 5. STAFF REPORT

- a. The presentation was made by Hailey de Anda, Supervisor, HIV Planning Council Office of Support (*See Appendix A*).
  - i. Working with Fast Track Cities on plan alignment with the Comprehensive Plan.
    - Dr. Huang will be moving on from Austin Public Health so will no longer be coordinating Fast Track Cities.
  - ii. Findings from HRSA Site Visit Final Report were reviewed by committee

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- Corrective Action plan was created in response to findings and Support Staff is working diligently on filling vacant categories and developing Spring Recruitment Plan to reflect the local demographics of HIV in the TGA.
- iii. Support Staff discussed the possibility of committee members transitioning to other committees.
  - Committee recommended developing clear guidance on how conflicted members could serve on Allocations Committee.
- iv. Planning Council members have been requested to present key takeaways from any conferences they attended such as the Annual Ryan White Conference or Texas State Syndicate Conference.

#### 6. 2019 COMMITTEE WORK PLAN ORIENTATION

- a. Mini-Training on Ryan White Legislative Requirements
  - i. Support Staff Laura Still presented Mini-Training on Needs Assessment (See Attachment A).
    - Training provided by Planning CHATT.
    - Comprehensive Planning Committee will begin preparing to enter Phase 3 of the Needs Assessment.
- b. Annual work plan review and discussion
  - i. Committee reviewed the annual work plan and the logic model.
  - Committee requested more information on how the assessment can inform the MAI Program as well more clarification on Allocations and Comprehensive Plan Committees role throughout this process.
  - iii. Committee would like to focus on capturing the voice of those who have fallen out of care.

#### 7. NEEDS ASSESSMENT PHASE II: CLOSE OUT

- a. Review needs assessment data
  - i. Committee reviewed needs assessment data collected from focus groups and key informant interviews.
    - Key recommendations established from data review:
      - **1.** Fund peer navigators for newly diagnosed individuals (i.e. directive and allocations for non-medical case management).
      - 2. Pilot rideshare program in the Austin TGA.
      - **3.** MAI program fund should address need for language and culturally competent services for Latinx/Hispanic population.
- b. Data Collection close out
  - i. All priority populations identified were reached. Three focus groups were completed and 6 key informant interviews completed/scheduled.

#### 8. NEEDS ASSESSMENT PHASE III: INTRODUCTION

- a. Special studies ideas discussed:
  - i. Housing/substance use
  - ii. Peer navigation
  - iii. Centralized eligibility
  - iv. Culturally competent services for Spanish Speakers
