SUBJECT: Response to Council Resolution No. 20180823-076 and Budget Rider A of Ordinance No.

20180911-001

Neighborhood Housing and Community Development Department staff has responded to the following resolutions through the implementation of the Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint, as described in the *Strategic Housing Blueprint Implementation Briefing Book*:

- Resolution No. 20180823-076 directing the City Manager to develop a plan to acquire and preserve multi-family developments and mobile home parks; and
- Budget Rider A of Ordinance No. 20180911-001 directing the urgent implementation of the 2018
 Affordable Housing bond (Proposition A) to address rapid gentrification, displacement, and
 homelessness and directing the City Manager to treat any Proposition A proceeds, related bond
 program, and other non-bond affordable housing resources with the same consideration as the
 Council prescribed for the 2016 Mobility Bond.

Staff presented comprehensive recommendations on the implementation of the <u>Austin Strategic Housing Blueprint</u> to the City Council's Housing and Planning Committee on February 12, 2019. These recommendations include strategies for: displacement mitigation, 2018 affordable housing bond implementation, preservation of existing affordable housing, acquisition and development of land for new affordable housing, and enhancement of Low Income Housing Tax Credit projects seeking City Council resolutions.
