**a.** Floodplain Regulations. Discuss and consider initiation of amendments to Title 25 of the City Code related to floodplain regulations. City Staff: Kevin Shunk, Watershed Protection Department, (512) 974-9176, Kevin.Shunk@austintexas.gov; (Discussion and/or Possible Action).

Kevin Shunk went over a presentation outlining needed changes to the LDC to reflect an updated understanding of rainfall, based on ATLAS 14. In Austin, the floodplain maps will change to reflect ATLAS 14; what was the 500 year floodplain will become the 100 year floodplain, and what was the 100 year floodplain will become the 25 year floodplain (roughly). A new redevelopment exception is being recommended, including an allowance to redevelop in the floodplain if freeboard is increased.

A motion was made to recommend the item to PC by Commissioner Kazi, seconded by Commissioner McGraw. Vote: 6-0.
