REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, February 25, 2019

The Human Rights Commission convened in a regular meeting on Monday, February 25, 2019 at 301 West Second Street in Austin, Texas.

Chair Sareta Davis called the Board Meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.
