


# **Project Updates**

- Communicate Directly with AE and 311
- Automate Manual Processes
- Provide In-Transit Visibility
- Increase Customer Service
- Conduct Staff Training








## **Project Updates**

#### **Enterprise Service Bus [ESB] Development:**

- In order for the collection vehicles to communicate directly with the COA Billing System and the COA Customer Service System, an Enterprise Service Bus (ESB) needs to be created
- The ESB will:
  - Allow the collection vehicles to communicate with 311 and AE
  - Eliminate manual processes
  - Increase customer service
- Working with AE, CTM and 311 to develop the ESB with FleetMind
- Currently some messages can be sent to and from the ESB
- FleetMind, 311 and AE updating their systems to allow all messages through the ESB







## **Project Updates**

#### **What Happens Next:**

- 100 of 220 vehicles currently installed from:
  - Trash
  - Recycling
  - Curbside Organics
- Next phase of installations June 2019
- AE updating CC&B (Billing System)
- 311 (Customer Service) updating Service Requests
- ESB testing to start August 2019
