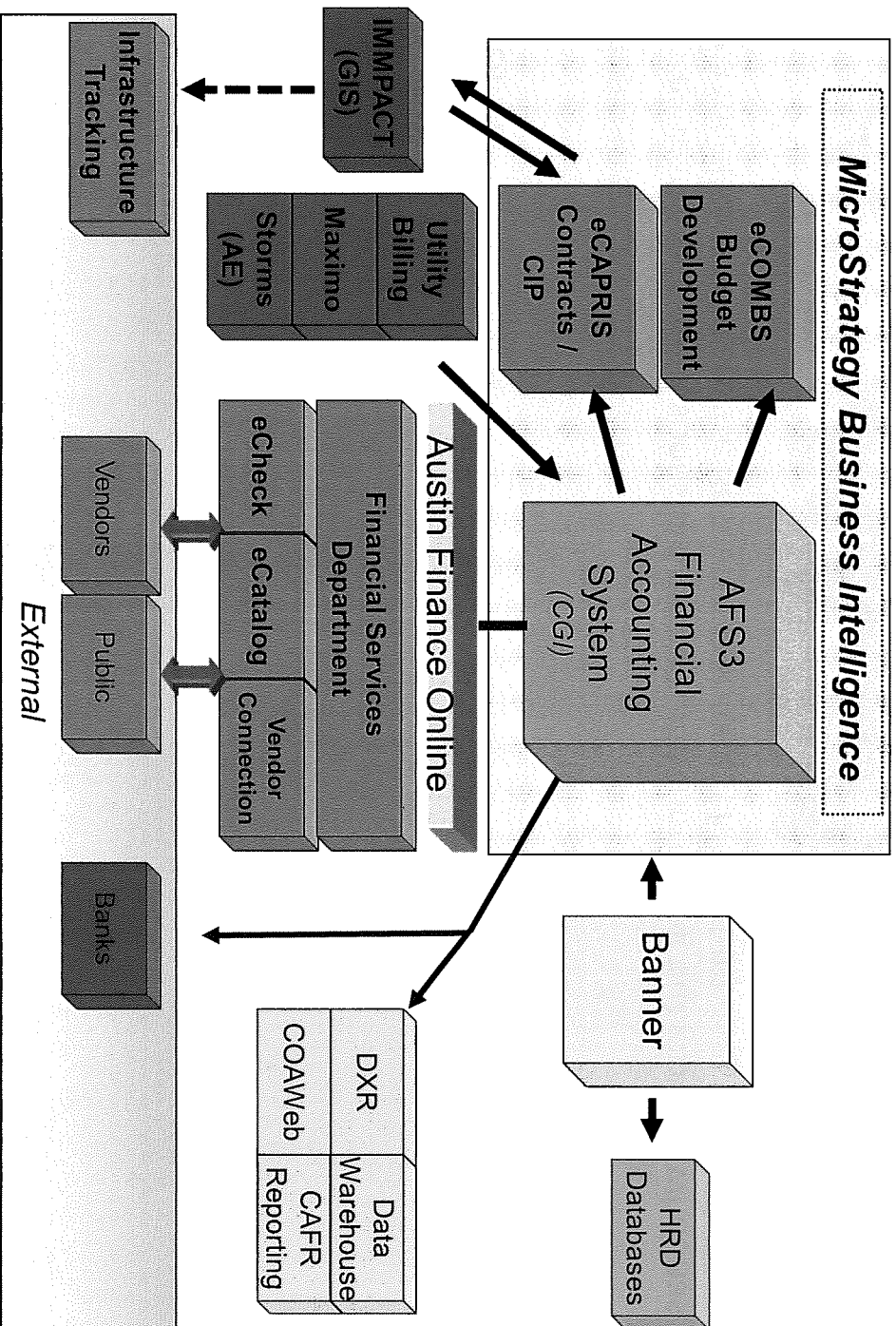

- **In-House Expertise**
 - Financial Services Group is very fortunate to have deep and comprehensive financial expertise and subject matter experts.
- **Distributed Resources**

 - Continuous award since 2014



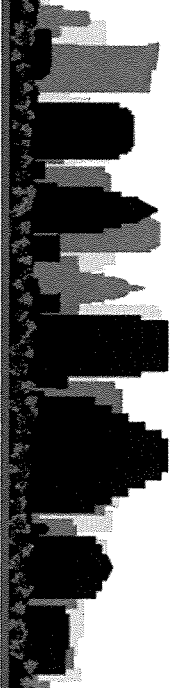
Overview of City Financial Systems

- Most visited City websites
 - Appears on lower left corner of the City's main web page, www.austintexas.gov
- Austin Finance Online is second most visited
 - Has been since its launch in 2010

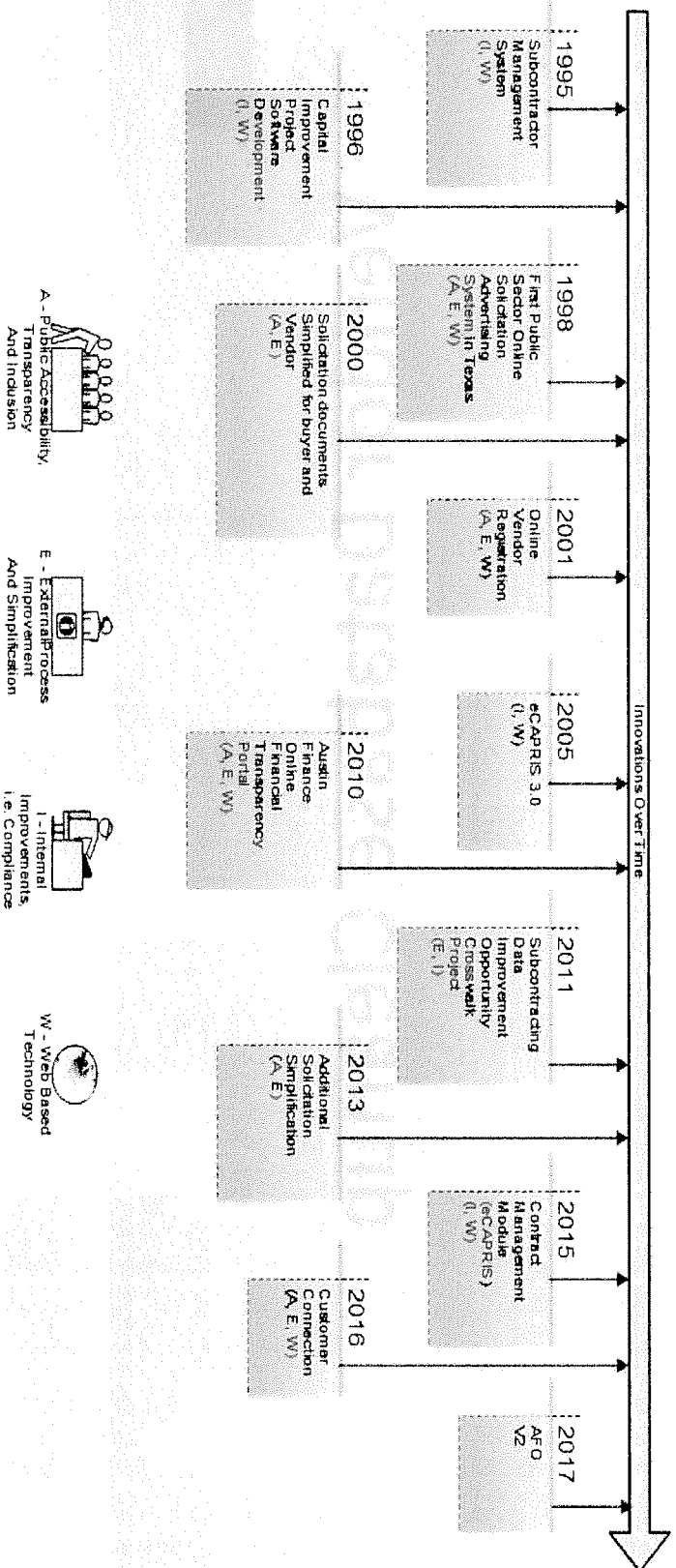

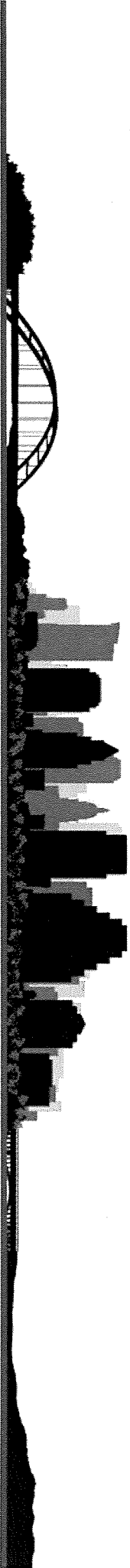
- The major components of the City's ERP are copyrighted

Overview

- Austin Finance Online / Vendor Connection

Scope

- Currently over 45,000 active registered Vendors

Included

- > 20,000 Vendors with no commodity codes (no notices)

Excluded

- Thousands with no or bad contact information (phone, e-mail)

Action

- Notifications statistics not meaningful

- Vendor accounts that included in this Cleanup (no recent activity)
 - No Commodity Codes selected
 - Inaccurate or Missing data
 - Have not subscribed to any solicitations in the last 2 years
 - No contracts, orders or payments in last 4 years
 - Have not updated their profile in the last 4 years
- Approx. 20,000 Vendors included in this Cleanup

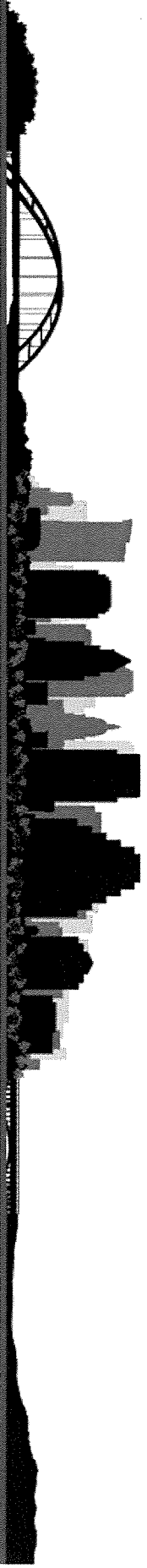

Milestones

- Vendor accounts excluded from this Cleanup (account types overlap)
 - Other Account Types (Customer, Subscriber, etc.)
 - M/WBE Certification past/present
 - Vendors with recent activity (2 – 4 years per criteria)
- Approx. 25,000 excluded from this Cleanup

Milestones

- Vendors need only to login to Vendor Connection and:
 - Review, change and confirm their contact information
 - Add at least one (1) commodity code
 - Add at least one (1) industry code
- Profiles from Vendors that do not respond may be:
 - Inactivated (No profiles will be Deleted)
 - Flagged ("Prevent New Spend")
- To Reactivate or Un-flag their profiles Vendors need only to login to Vendor Connection and provide the required updates (see above)

Included

- Vendors update their accounts

Jan – Mar 2018

Excluded

Action

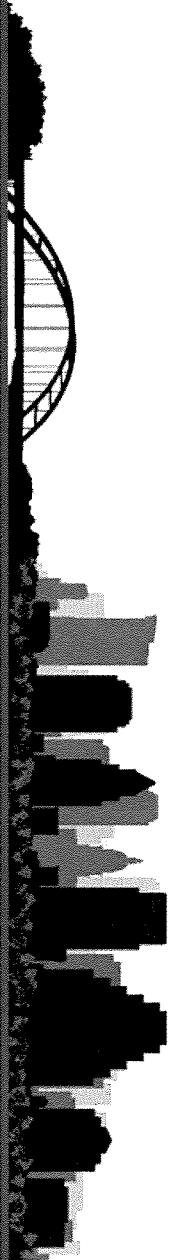
- USPS notices to all unresponsive accounts

Overview

- City performs over 360 solicitations per year

Scope

- All responses are still physically received, opened and stored

Included

Excluded

Action

Milestones

- Hardcopy offers are costly to the City and Vendors
 - Materials, creation and delivery
 - Receiving, opening, replicating back into electronic copy
 - Physical security, storage, archival
 - Limited / diminishing participation in City solicitations

- Authorize and implement Online Bid Receipt
- More fully utilize existing procurement tools / systems
- Increase City of Austin Procurement's Value-Add:
 - Increase efficiency, transparency, and participation
 - Drive better pricing, contract terms and value
 - Enhance ability to meet Council policy objectives
 - Continue to ensure public trust and confidence



Online Bid Receipt

Overview

- Purchasing Office and Capitol Contracting Office only

Scope

Included

- Initially non-complex Invitation for Bids (IFB) only, eventually all formal solicitations including construction

Excluded

- Enable subsequent implementations

Action

- Non-competitive processes, e.g., RFI
- Informal solicitations

- Will continue to allow submission of hardcopy Offers
 - Other competitive processes not included initially:
 - Real estate transactions
 - 380 Agreements
 - Human service solicitations
 - Airport concessions solicitations
 - Austin Housing Finance Corporation solicitations
 - Others

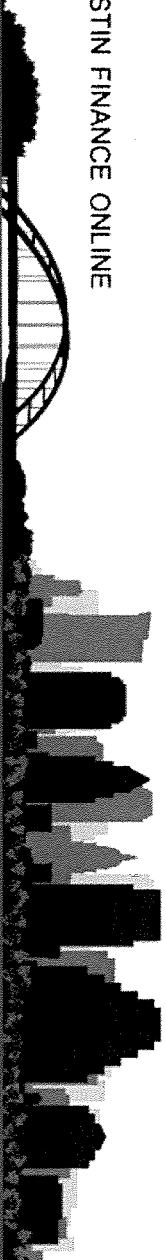
