



Austin Point in Time Count (PIT) Data




Persons Counted Experiencing Homelessness in Point-in-Time Counts (PIT)



Downtown Austin Plan (DAP) Area Trend






In the DAP Area:

- There are approximately 800 people experiencing homelessness on any given night.
- This number increased 6% from 2017 to 2019.

Within 1/4 Mile of 7th and Neches:

- 1/3 of
 Austin's total
 homeless
 population
- 1/4 of Austin's unsheltered population

Downtown Austin Alliance Key Areas of Focus



- 1. Increase emergency shelter with 500 additional beds
 - Safe alternatives to being unsheltered
 - Navigation services to address needs and move people toward housing
 - Temporary step to long term stability
- 2. Create a comprehensive homeless services database
 - Maintain with live info on availability of services
 - Accessible to individuals and all service providers
- 3. Build private public sector leadership and private/public partnership
 - Develop a prioritized plan
 - Increase funding and resources for immediate solutions
 - Push the pace of progress more must happen faster
- 4. Focus immediate attention on outreach and engagement of people on the streets with substance addictions and mental illness
