Subject: City of Austin's Coal Tar Pavement Sealant Ban

Motion by: Linda Guerrero Seconded by: Mary Ann Neely

RATIONALE:

WHEREAS, Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAHs) are ever-present in the urban environment; and

WHEREAS, varying levels of exposure to PAHs from sealants are toxic to human and aquatic health; and

WHEREAS, the Watershed Protection Department proposes amending the ordinance from 2005 for increase protection to residents and aquatic life; and

WHEREAS, ten states have coal tar bans within their boundaries in addition to four states with state-wide bans.

THEREFORE, the Environmental Commission recommends supporting staff recommendations to amend Chapter 6-6 of the City Code with the following:

Staff Conditions

- Add "High PAH Pavement Products" to the ban, which would include:
- Coal tar products
- Coal tar-related products
- Ethylene cracker residue (ECR) products and their derived products; and
- Any pavement product over .1% PAH by weight

Environmental Commission Conditions

The Environmental Commission recommends that Chapter 6-6-4 EXEMPTIONS (2) of the City Code be removed.
