





Application for Naming a Park Feature

Please follow the instructions below when submitting an application for naming or renaming a feature.

- 1. Complete the application by providing detailed information about the park feature to be named or renamed. Please include any supplemental information such as articles, letters of support and signature list with the application. The application must contain documentation of public support for the proposed name. Public support materials must be provided to the Parks and Recreation Department.
- 2. Please provide payment of the Application Fee, \$365.00 in the form of a cashier's check. Checks should be made out to City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department and submitted with the application.
- 3. A Sign Fabrication Fee in the amount of \$940.00 will apply, should the Parks and Recreation Director approve the application. A cashier's check should be made out to City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department.
