BUILDING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION

The Board/Commission mission statement is:

The Building and Standards Commission (BSC) was established to hear cases concerning alleged violations of the City's housing and dangerous building regulations.

The Building and Standards Commission shall have the powers and duties and comply with the procedures established by Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 54, Subchapter C (Quasi-Judicial Enforcement of Health and Safety Ordinances), and Chapter 25-12, Article 9 (Property Maintenance Code) of the Austin City Code.

- 1. Describe the board's actions supporting their mission during the previous calendar year. Address all elements of the board's mission statement as provided in the relevant sections of the City Code.
 - The Commission met on 10 occasions to hear cases involving, appeals, and substandard / dangerous properties.
 - The Commission heard a total of 31 new cases.
 - The Commission heard a total of 19 returning cases.
 - The Commission heard **167** updates.
 - The Commission held 10 out of 11 scheduled meetings during this period, with one meeting cancelled due to lack of quorum.
- 2. Determine if the board's actions throughout the year comply with the mission statement.
 - The Commission issued 21 repair orders.
 - The Commission issued 6 demolition orders.
 - The Commission issued 1 order for an engineer's report.
 - The Commission heard 10 appeals.
 - The Commission issued 1 reduced civil penalty order.
 - The Commission reduced the civil penalty to \$0 in 7 cases.

- The Commission has complied with its mission to hear and act on cases pertaining to substandard and dangerous structures in the City.
- The Commission's actions directly resulted in eliminating substandard and dangerous conditions at properties throughout the City.
