The design plans for the Little Walnut/Buttermilk-North/Capital project in the Austin Clean Water Program require the acquisition of a permanent wastewater line easement and a temporary working space easement across land located at 408 East Rundberg Lane.


The City of Austin has attempted to purchase the permanent wastewater line easement and temporary working space easement from the landowner, however, the parties have been unable to agree on an appropriate price. The City has not received a counteroffer to its \$8,956 offer. The Law Department is requesting authorization to file a lawsuit in eminent domain on behalf of the City of Austin to acquire both easements.
