### A. CALL TO ORDER

### C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes from the June 12, 2019 Water & Wastewater Commission regular meeting were approved on a 6-0-0-5 vote on Commissioner Moriarty's motion and Commissioner Castleberry's second with Commissioners Ho, and Parton off the dais. Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta were absent.

# D. ITEMS FOR COMMISSION'S REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL TO CITY COUNCIL

1. Recommend approval to authorize award of a multi-term contract with **Shrieve Chemical Company**, to provide anhydrous ammonia, for up to five years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,600,000. **Recommended by the Water & Wastewater Commission on Commissioner Moriarty's motion and Commissioner Castleberry's second on a 6-0-0-5 vote with Commissioners Ho and Parton off the dais, and Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta absent.** 

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- 2. Recommend approval to authorize negotiation and execution of a multi-term cooperative contract with WW Grainger Inc., to provide industrial supplies, equipment, tools, and services, for up to 53 months for a total contract amount not to exceed \$25,702,750. Austin Water's requested authorization is \$6,625,000. Recommended by the Water & Wastewater Commission on Commissioner Moriarty's motion and Commissioner Castleberry's second on a 6-0-0-5 vote with Commissioners Ho and Parton off the dais, and Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta absent.
- 3. Recommend approval to authorize award of a multi-term contract with Carus Corporation, to provide liquid phosphate, for up to five years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,750,000. Recommended by the Water & Wastewater Commission on Commissioner Moriarty's motion and Commissioner Castleberry's second on a 6-0-0-5 vote with Commissioners Ho and Parton off the dais, and Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta absent.
- 4. Recommend approval to authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with CAS Consulting & Services, Inc. for engineering services for the Williamson Creek Wastewater Interceptor project in the amount of \$2,400,995.53, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$6,459,995.53. (Districts 2 and 3). Recommended by the Water & Wastewater Commission on Commissioner Ho's motion to approve, Commissioner Parton's second on a 6-0-2-3 vote with Commissioners Penn, and Lee recused, and Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta absent.
- 5. Recommend approval to authorize the negotiation and execution of a financing agreement with the **Texas Water Development Board** (**TWDB**) for a 20-year low interest loan in the amount of \$6,200,000 through TWDB's State Water Implementation Fund for Texas (SWIFT) loan program, for the implementation of Austin Water's Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) project. **Recommended by the Water & Wastewater Commission on an 8-0-0-3 vote on Commissioner Moriarty's motion and Commissioner Schmitt's second with Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta absent.**
- 6. Recommend approval to include Austin Water (AW) Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) located in the Drinking Water Protection Zone (DWPZ) in AW's 5-year capital spending plan. Recommended by the Water & Wastewater Commission on Commissioner Moriarty's motion and Commissioner Castleberry's second on a 6-0-0-5 vote with Commissioners Ho and Parton off the dais, and Commissioners Michel, Williams and Turrieta absent.
