The County was awarded a grant from the Office of Rural Community Affairs (ORCA) to allow first time water services to approximately 10 residential homes along Plover Place Road. Because all of the residents to be served by the water project are of low to moderate income, the County cannot, according to HUD regulations, require residents to pay tap fees and capital recovery fees. The County felt that without some assistance from the City, they would not be able to proceed with the project because of limited funds to complete the construction and pay the required fees. On June 12, 2003, the County approached the City Council seeking Council approval of a waiver of the tap fees and capital recovery fees for the homes that would be connected to the water improvements. Instead of approving the waiver of tap fees and capital recovery fees, the Council directed the Austin Water Utility (Utility) to work with Travis County on a cost-sharing plan.

Under the proposed Interlocal Agreement, the County would pay the City \$138,000 of the \$189,820 grant money for the construction of ~3,700 feet of 8 inch water main to cover the cost of labor and materials. The Utility will be responsible for engineering design, project management and surveying cost. estimated at \$12,500. The County has determined that 10 homes qualify for the grant for water service and will pay \$14,638.40 in matching funds towards the cost of tap and capitol recovery fees. The County will use the remaining \$51,820 for administrating the grant, final roadway trench repair, private water service installation, legal lot determination and easement acquisition.

It is anticipated that the 30 year net present value for this area will be \$43,875.
