Pedestrian Advisory Council Recommendation:

City of Austin updates regarding new or upgraded pedestrian infrastructure

WHEREAS, the Pedestrian Advisory Council's (PAC) purpose is to advise the City of Austin and other entities on pedestrian planning, policy, design, funding, education, and enforcement regarding creating, maintaining, and operating pedestrian facilities;

WHEREAS, thanks to new funding sources, support from elected officials and the public, and staff commitment, the City of Austin has in recent years accelerated pedestrian infrastructure improvements;

WHEREAS, regularly updating the public through the PAC, social media, and other channels about new pedestrian infrastructure could help foster strong and widespread support for funding for more such facilities;

WHEREAS, visual images can be effective in quickly and effectively capturing public attention;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the PAC recommends that the City of Austin provide regular public updates, through social media and other platforms, about all recently completed and noteworthy pedestrian infrastructure projects, such updates appropriately tagged for findability and sortability, geographically locatable, and including photos taken before and after such projects were completed.
