Current state

- Online information on mobility projects limited to minimal schedule and status notes on projects funded through capital investment
- Individual workgroups teams track mobility projects in separate, disconnected systems
- Software lacks robust functionality and integrations, leading to redundant, poor-quality data
- Reporting is time-consuming and unreliable

/ How might we support comprehensive tracking of Austin's mobility activities?

Mobility Project Database (MPD)

Application for City of Austin staff to track mobility projects

- Common data structure across mobility projects
- Standardized process to track projects from planning to implementation
- User-friendly features to help staff maintain accurate data efficiently
- Integrations with existing enterprise platforms to eliminate data redundancy

MPD-enabled reporting capabilities

- Centralized, consistent, and reliable data on mobility activities in Austin
- Reports on the status of pedestrian infrastructure projects can be delivered on a regular basis
- Staff can easily pull tabular data on specific areas of interest

Mobility Project Database timeline


- September-December, 2019: User interviews and technical research
- January-February, 2020: Design data model and develop feature-based roadmap
- March-May, 2020: Implementation and pilot launch
- June-August, 2020: User testing and improvements
- September 2020: MPD 1.0 rollout, begin work on public-facing dashboard


Future state

- Mobility Project Database used across City departments and partner organizations to track mobility projects






All Ages and Abilities Bicycle Network


