<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of Amendment No. 11 to a professional services agreement with BUSINESS RESOURCE CONSULTANTS (MBE/FB), Austin, TX, to extend the contract on a month to month basis for nine months in an amount not to exceed \$71,450 to provide African-American owned construction businesses with a support network and technical assistance for the Development Assistance Services Program, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$817,577.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$71,450 is included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Approved Operating Budget of the Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office.

<u>MBE / WBE:</u> This contract was awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

Business Resource Consultants provides cost estimating assistance for small contractors, legal services and training useful to small business owners, such as understanding and evaluating contracts, marketing, bidding, and financing.

The Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office (EGRSO), through the Small Business Development Program (SBDP), is requesting authorization to extend this contract on a month-to-month basis from January 1, 2004 through September 30, 2004. During the FY 2004 Budget Approval hearings, Council directed staff to extend this contract on a month-to-month basis to avoid disrupting services to Business Resource Consultants' clients while the City completes implementation of a new small business development services delivery system. The contract was extended administratively for the period of October 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

The SBDP has been working since 2000 to complete Council's directive to develop a comprehensive strategy for delivering effective and cost-efficient services to small business owners. The



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recommendations for the new delivery strategy and its service components have been finalized. An RFP will be issued in 2004 to solicit these services, and the resulting contracts are expected to be effective October 1, 2004.
