a) Community Climate Plan Update – Zach Baumer, Office of Sustainability (Discussion and/or possible action) – 30 minutes

- Advisory Group and Steering Committee meetings have started
- Over 150 participants across these groups along with 10 individual and 3 organizations chosen as Community Climate Ambassadors
- Completed a series of equity and climate workshops throughout early December

 - Recommendations require additional follow-up
 - Council committee makes decision to place things on agenda, so there is opportunity to make agenda requests to council
- c) JSC Recommendations on Land Development Code Revision (Discussion and/or possible action) 45 minutes
 - Three recommendations proposed:
 - Recommendation adopting an equity-impact analysis addressing displacement concerns for low-income, communities of color in the Land Development Code revision
 - Record of the vote: Motion (Commissioner Phillips), Second (Commissioner White). Motion passes 8 approve, 0 opposed.
 - Recommendation adopting tree preservation standards to verify survival of newly planted trees and preserve tree canopy
 - Record of the vote: Motion (Commissioner Ho), Second (Commissioner White). Motion passes 8 approve, 0 opposed.
 - Recommendation adopting a charitable feeding organization permit process to reduce barriers for providing access to healthy food to food insecure populations
 - Commissioners to revisit recommendation at next January meeting
