

RESOLUTION NO. 040129-14

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin, to authorize the application for and acceptance of \$66,328 in continuation grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division to fund one full-time equivalent (FTE) Detective position in the Sex Offender Apprehension and Registration (SOAR) Unit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for and acceptance of State continuation grant funds for said project, in the amount of \$66,328 from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, to fund one full-time equivalent (FTE) Detective position and related equipment in the Sex Offender Apprehension and Registration (SOAR) Unit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates Laura Huffman as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant; and


WHEREAS, the City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice division in full; **NOW THEREFORE**,
