FY 2019-20 ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT PRIORITIES TO PREVENT, PREPARE FOR, AND RESPOND TO CORONAVIRUS

Emergency Rental Assistance and Homelessness Assistance to Prevent, Prepare for, and Respond to Coronavirus

- Emergency rental assistance for low-and moderate-income households
- Homelessness assistance to mitigate the economic effects of Coronavirus
- Housing and shelter assistance for persons experiencing homelessness

Community Development Assistance to Prevent, Prepare for, and Respond to Coronavirus

 Small business assistance to retain jobs held by low-and moderateincome persons working in child care centers

Special Needs Assistance to Prevent, Prepare for, and Respond to Coronavirus

- Respite care for children whose parents or guardians are hospitalized or quarantined, overnight and weekend child care for essential workers, and health and safety supplies needed for child care programs
- Short-term housing and utility assistance, tenant based rental assistance, hotel/motel voucher assistance, housing placement and supportive services, and master leasing

- Mental health services for at-risk youth
- Childcare services
- Services for Seniors

Community Development Assistance

- Capacity building for nonprofit organizations focused on affordable housing
- Workforce development
- Support for small business development

Housing Development Assistance

Assistance to nonprofit and for-profit developers to build affordable housing for lowand moderate-income households, and to acquire real property for affordable housing purposes.

Homeowner Assistance

Services to homeowners that need assistance with making the home safe, functional and/or accessible.

Renter Assistance

- Provide assistance for more affordable rent
- Provide Tenants' Rights
 Services
- Financial Assistance to make rental units more accessible

Homebuyer Assistance

- Counseling to renters wishing to become homebuyers
- Down Payment Assistance Program
