That the membership of the Austin Clean Economy Team include, but not be limited to, representatives of the City of Austin Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services, Austin Energy, the City of Austin Water Utility, the City of Austin Law Department and the City of Austin Watershed Protection and Development Review Department.
