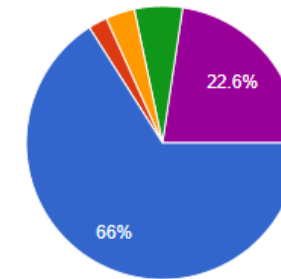

Do you support the Austin Healthy Streets Initiative?

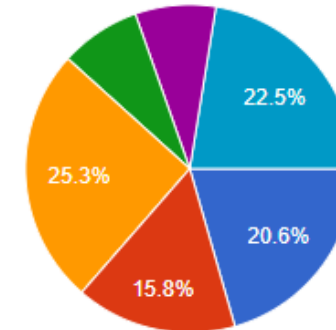

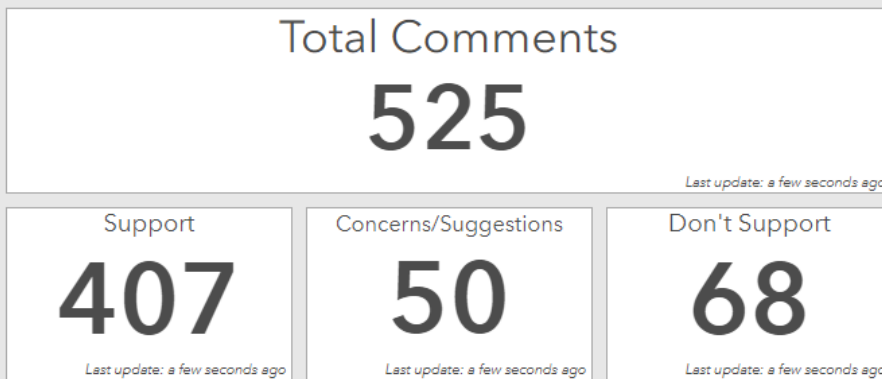
How often do you use Healthy Streets?

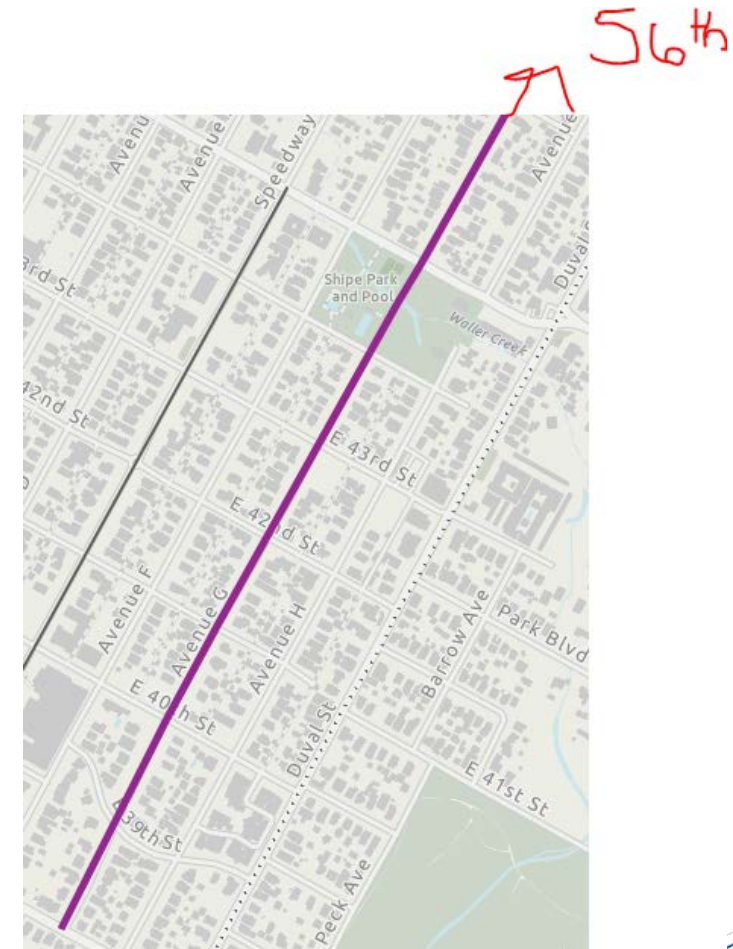
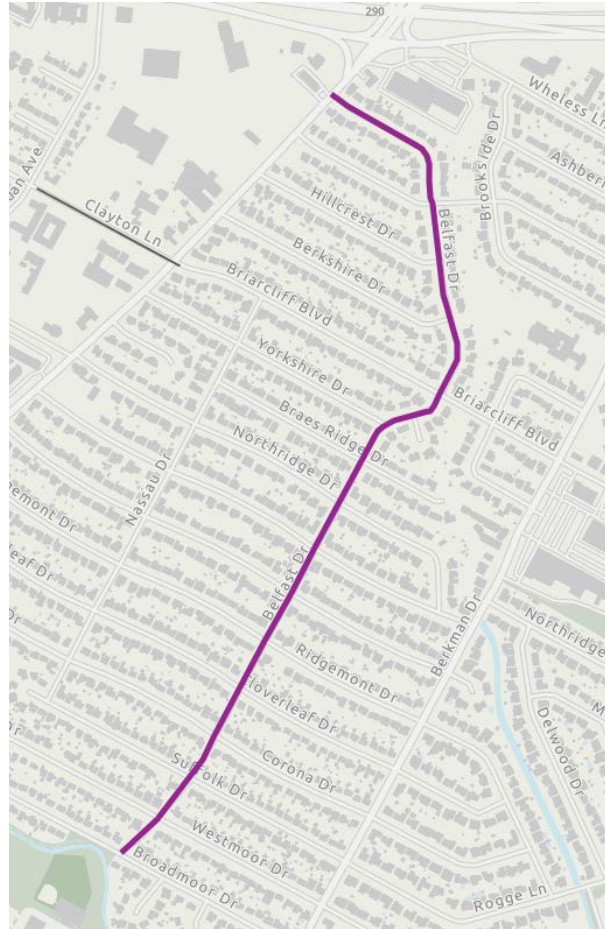
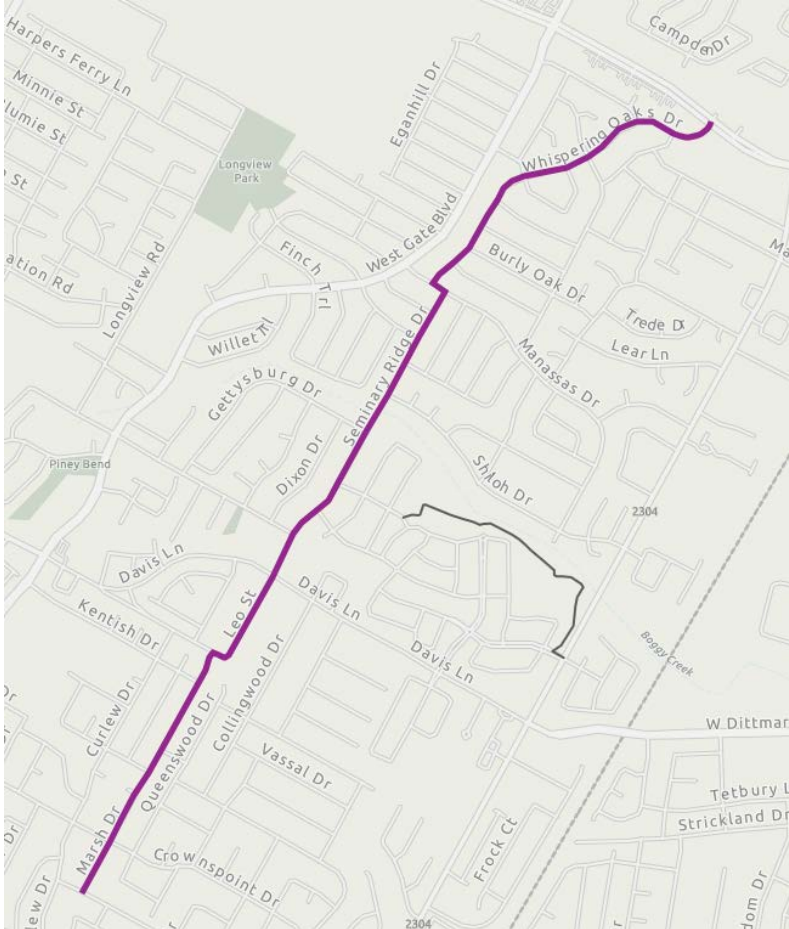
