

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ZONE SPEED LIMIT

Pursuant to Section 12-4-41 of the Austin City Code, the City Traffic Engineer has determined that a special hazard exists, and a temporary reduced speed limit is required to protect the public safety and welfare.

Once the required signs are installed, any speed in excess of the temporary construction zone speed limit shall be unlawful.

STREETS AFFECTED: 6300-6500 blocks of E. William Cannon Drive

TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ZONE SPEED LIMIT: 35 mph

EFFECTIVE DATE: September 05, 2020 – October 20, 2020

The temporary construction zone speed limit shall last no longer than 90 days but may be extended for up to 90 days following the posting of notice of extension of a temporary construction zone speed limit.
